**100<sup>th</sup> ASG Motorcycle Safety Training Schedule**  
**1st Quarter FY 05**

The 100<sup>th</sup> Area Support Group will be offering Motorcycle Operator Training at Grafenwöhr and Hohenfels. Two approved MSF courses will be offered at each location.

1. The Basic Rider Course (BRC) consists of 16 hours of combined classroom and practical instruction. This course of instruction is required for personnel applying for a first time operator endorsement and who cannot produce a MSF completion certificate.

2. The Experienced Rider Course (ERC) consists of 5-8 hours of practical instruction and does not involve classroom work. Attendees should plan on being outside the entire day and dress appropriately. USAREUR personnel who either renew or apply for a motorcycle operator endorsement, have in their possession a MSF course completion card over 3 years old, will be required to attend this course before issuance of a permanent operator endorsement.

Motorcycle license applicants or renewals requiring instruction will be issued a 60 day temporary operating permit by the Drivers License Testing Station providing that all other requirements are met IAW AE 190-1.

The 100<sup>th</sup> ASG will be conducting multiple ERC sessions at both training locations. Personnel, who unsuccessfully complete the course, will be asked to return at a later date and complete the 2 day BRC. Training will be conducted on the scheduled dates (below) unless a condition exists that would make instruction unsafe. The maximum number of riders is six per instructor. All of the scheduled courses have two instructors and a maximum of 12 attendees per course. See course schedule below.

The rider should be prepared for inclement weather and wear the proper protective equipment as stipulated by the AE 190-1. Improperly attired riders will not be allowed to participate.

**Proposed course dates for the first quarter FY-05 are as follows:**

**Grafenwoehr – Camp Kasareen training course. A map to Camp Kasareen is shown on the following pages. START TIME IS 0800!**

October 21 - ERC

November 10 - ERC  
November 8/9 - BRC

December 7 - ERC

**Hohenfels – Hardstand #3 in the Albertshof footprint. A map to Hardstand # 3 is shown on the following pages. START TIME IS 0900!**

October 28 - ERC  
October 26/27 - BRC

November 15 - ERC

December 13 - ERC  
December 14/15 - BRC

This schedule fulfills the minimum requirements of providing an ERC and BRC at each location monthly. As needs dictate this schedule will be modified to meet demand. Minimum class size is 3 people.


# Grafenwöhr

**From Amberg** go on Bundesstraße 299 direction Grafenwöhr as far as Tanzfleck entrance (Gate 4).

Proceed about 6 km / 3.7 miles to Camp Kasserine on the left.






# Motorcycle Safety Training

How to get there:

**From Weiden** go on Bundesstraße 470 direction Grafenwöhr following the signs for Grafenwöhr Training Area to Gate 3. Proceed about 3.8 km / 2.4 mi through the maincamp and on the tanktrail to Camp Kasserine on the right.






# Hohenfels Motorcycle Safety Training

How to get there:

**From A3**, exit Parsberg. Head away from the ESSO and proceed to **Gate 5**. Continue down Gate 5 road once the hill is crested look for the course on the left hand side.

**From Gate 1** proceed down General Patton, out to Albertshof. At the 5 point intersection turn left and the course is on the right, half way up the hill.

**From Graf/Vilseck enter Gate 3** proceed to main post. Turn right at the “T” intersection in front of the PX. proceed down General Patton, out to Albertshof. At the 5 point intersection turn left and the course is on the right half way up the hill.

How to get there:
