### Hazardous Substance Group

**Antifreeze (Ethylene glycol)**  
Antifreeze used for engine radiator

### Hazard for Human Health and the Environment



- Harmful to health/noxious after swallowing or contact to skin

### Protective Measures and Behaviour Rules



- During use wear **safety goggles** and **protective gloves**
- Avoid contact with eyes and skin



### Behavior in Danger Situations



- **Accidental release:** Use adsorbent for cleaning of spillages/leakages of liquids (Spill Kit!), put contaminated adsorbent into designated waste container.

### First Aid



- After **eye contact:** Immediately flush thoroughly with plenty of water for at least 10 minutes, contact eye specialist
- After **skin contact:** Immediately wash with water and soap thoroughly, immediately take off contaminated clothes
- After **swallowing:** Rinse mouth thoroughly and then drink plenty of water, immediately get medical attention

### Proper Disposal



Collect waste/residuals in a resistant, closed and labelled container and keep at the HWAP prior to proper disposal. Collect used antifreeze separately (recycling!).
