Gesundheitsschädlich

- Harmful to health after contact to skin or swallowing
- Diesel fuel is a water endangering substance (WGK 2) - avoid spillage to soil, waterways or sewer system

Protective Measures and Behaviour Rules



- During handling wear **protective gloves** and **safety goggles**
- Avoid contact to skin and eyes
- Keep away from fire and source of ignition sources (e.g. hot parts, open fires, cigarettes etc.) - Do not smoke



Behavior in Danger Situations



- **Accidental release:** Use adsorbent for cleaning of spillages/leakages of liquids (Spill Kit!), put contaminated adsorbent into designated waste container

First Aid



- After **eye contact:** Immediately flush thoroughly with plenty of water for at least 10 minutes, contact eye specialist
- After **skin contact:** Immediately wash with water and soap thoroughly, immediately take off contaminated clothes
- After **inhalation:** Remove to fresh air
- After **swallowing:** Rinse mouth thoroughly and then drink plenty of water, immediately get medical attention

Proper Disposal



Collect contaminated diesel fuel in a separate, resistant, closed and labelled container and keep at the HWAP prior to proper disposal
