

These General Operating Instructions provide an overview on the different hazard categories, including related warning signs. In addition a list and description is given for mandatory signs. Also, general behavior rules are listed for the use/storage of hazardous substances, which supplement the operating instructions for hazardous substance groups and the respective **Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS)** of each product.

General Hazards for Human Health and the Environment

Hazard Category		Warning Sign	Description of Warning Sign
 Reizend	 Gesundheitsschädlich		Danger of substances harmful to health
 Leichtentzündlich	 Hochentzündlich		Danger of flammable and highly flammable substances
 Brandfördernd			Danger of oxidizing substances
 Explosionsgefährlich			Danger of explosives
 Ätzend			Danger of corrosives
 Giftig	 Sehr giftig		Danger of toxic and very toxic substances
 Umweltgefährlich			Danger of substances harmful to the environment

General Protective Measures and Behaviour Rules

- Any use of hazardous substances must be done with special care and diligence!
- In rooms where hazardous substances are used/stored, do not eat, drink, smoke or take a sniff!
- In any case, special attention must be paid to any further information as included in the operating instructions and the MSDS of every hazardous material in use!
- Do not use inappropriate, damaged or not properly labeled containers. In particular, hazardous substances must not be stored in containers, which could be mistaken for food containers!
- Personal safety equipment must be worn as required for protection against the effects of hazardous substances !
- Generally, the inhalation of vapors and dusts, and the contact of eyes and skin with hazardous substances should be carefully avoided!
- Keep containers tightly closed if not in use!
- Hazardous substances can be waster endangering - do not permit product to enter sewers, streams or other waterways, dike spills and eliminate leaks!
- Do not eat or drink during handling of product. Do not store food or drinks at workplace or storage!
- Wash hand thoroughly after breaks and completion of work!

Behavior in Danger Situations



- In an emergency case, keep calm and act thoughtfully!
- Always warn surrounding area, in particular people which are in danger; if necessary, leave danger zone!
