Fuel (e.g. MOGAS), contact during repair/maintenance of engines

Hazard for Human Health and the Environment



- inflammable – Danger of formation of explosive/inflammable vapor-air-mixtures
- Danger of serious damage to health during prolonged exposure
- Toxic during inhalation, swallowing and contact to skin (degreasing effect on skin)
- May cause cancer during inhalation
- Vapors are invisible and sink to the ground
- Heating oil is a water endangering substance (WGK 3) - avoid spillage to soil, waterways or sewer system



Protective Measures and Behaviour Rules



- During handling wear **safety goggles** and **protective gloves**, breathing protection is recommended
- Keep away from sources of ignition – do not smoke.
- Avoid contact to eyes, skin and mucous membranes - do not inhale vapors
- Only use in well-ventilated areas (especially at ground level)
- Avoid discharge into the drain – Danger of explosion!
- Keep container tightly closed



Behavior in Danger Situations



- **Extinguishing media:** Use the fire extinguisher for small initial fires – do not use water for fire extinguishing. If the fire cannot be controlled, leave the danger area immediately and call the fire department
- **Accidental release:** Use adsorbent for cleaning of spillages/leakages of liquids (Spill Kit!), put contaminated adsorbent into designated waste container

First Aid



- After **eye contact:** Immediately flush thoroughly with plenty of water for at least 10 minutes, contact eye specialist
- After **skin contact:** Immediately wash with water and soap thoroughly, immediately take off contaminated clothes
- After **inhalation:** Remove to fresh air, get medical attention
- After **swallowing:** Rinse mouth thoroughly and then drink plenty of water, immediately get medical attention
- Use water for cooling of burns, get medical attention
